Stuenkel Road Interchange Construction Work Resumes

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that weather permitting, work for the new interchange on I-57 at Stuenkel Road near the Village of University Park will resume on Monday, March 23.

In order to complete the work, shoulders along both northbound and southbound I-57 will be closed between Monee-Manhattan Road and Steger Road.

Project work includes but is not limited to the construction of ramps, pavement reconstruction and road widening. The project is anticipated to be completed by October 2015.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
