Roadwork along Route 83 in Willowbrook

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that lane closures will occur for roadwork along Route 83 in Willowbrook, beginning, weather permitting, Monday, April 13.

In order to complete the work, the following changes will impact traffic along Route 83 between County Line and Knollwood Road:

- Northbound and southbound traffic will be reduced to one lane from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- The left turn lanes will be maintaining during patching operations
- All lanes will be reopened to traffic from 5 a.m to 8 p.m.
- One shoulder and one lane will be closed in the northbound direction between 9 a.m. and 5 p.m.
- One shoulder and one lane will be closed in the southbound direction between 7 a.m. and 3 p.m.

Roadwork, which includes repaving and drainage repair, will be completed by mid-October 2015.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
