## **Lane Reductions along IL 21 in Niles / Glenview**

**CHICAGO** – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that lane reductions will occur for a resurfacing project beginning along Illinois Route 21 in Niles and Glenview, weather permitting, Monday, April 20.

In order to complete the work, during daytime hours, the northern and southern directions of IL 21 will be reduced to one lane in each direction between Touhy Avenue and Glenview Road.

The project will be complete by the end of August.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
