Lane closures along US 41 in Gurnee and Wadsworth

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that lane reductions and closures will occur along US 41 in Gurnee and Wadsworth for a resurfacing project beginning, weather permitting, Monday, May 4.

In order to complete the work, the northbound and southbound directions of US 41 will be reduced to one lane in each direction with nightly lane closures between Illinois Route 21 and Interstate 94. During the daytime hours, shoulder closures will be utilized at various locations throughout the duration of the project.

The project will be complete by the end of November.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
