Repairs and Construction along Ashland Avenue in Blue Island and Dixmoor

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that road work will resume along Ashland Avenue near Blue Island and Dixmoor, for drainage repair and safety updates beginning, weather permitting, Wednesday, April 8.

In order to complete the work, Ashland Avenue temporary daytime lane closures and narrow lanes should be expected between Broadway Street and Thornton Road.

Work on this project also includes the construction of a concrete barrier wall, guardrail installation and landscaping.

The project will be complete by July 15.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
