Westbound Irving Park Road closed in Itasca

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that lane closures will occur along Irving Park Road in Itasca for sewer and pavement repair beginning, weather permitting, the morning of Tuesday, May 12.

In order to complete the work, westbound Irving Park Road will be closed from just west of Maple Avenue to Catalpa Avenue. Traffic will be able to access one westbound and one eastbound lane of Irving Park Road.

The project is slated to be complete by Wednesday, May 13, at 7 p.m.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
