Bridge Inspections, Ramp Closures Early Sunday at Kingery, Bishop Ford, Tri-State Interchange

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that routine bridge inspections at the interchange of the Kingery Expressway (Interstate 80/94), Bishop Ford Freeway (Interstate 94/Illinois 394) and the Tri-State Tollway (Interstate 80/294) near South Holland will require short-term ramp closures during the early morning hours of Sunday, May 10.

Weather permitting, the following closures will take place:

- Between 1 and 3:30 a.m., the ramp from the eastbound Tri-State (I-294) to the northbound Bishop Ford (I-94) will be closed. Eastbound drivers will be detoured to the Torrence Avenue exit and entrance ramps to access the northbound Bishop Ford via the westbound I-80/94.
- Between 3:30 and 5 a.m., the ramp from the westbound Kingery (I-80/94) to southbound Illinois 394 will be closed. Westbound drivers will be detoured to the 159nd Street (U.S. 6) westbound exit to access the southbound Bishop Ford.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
