## **Lane reduction along 70<sup>th</sup> Street over Flag Creek**

**CHICAGO** – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that lane reductions and closures will occur for bridge deck and joint repairs, guardrail improvements and striping all for the structure carrying along 70<sup>th</sup> Place in Indian Head Park over the Flag Creek beginning, weather permitting, Monday, June 22.

In order to complete the work, the bridge over Flag Creek will be reduced to one lane with traffic moving one direction at a time. Temporary signals will be installed along Wolf Road and 70<sup>th</sup> Street to facilitate traffic flow.

The project will be complete by the end of August.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
