165th Street Closure in Orland Park

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that 165th Street between LaGrange Road (U.S. 45) and 97th Avenue, in Orland Park, will be closed for intersection reconstruction beginning, weather permitting, on Tuesday, July 14.

In order to complete the work, a detour will be posted directing motorists to 163rd Street and 97th Avenue. All businesses along 165th Street will remain accessible.

The road closure will be removed during the first week of August.

The work is a part of the ongoing widening and reconstruction of LaGrange Road through Orland Park, Orland Hills, Palos Park and Tinley Park, from 131st Street to 179th Street.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
