Peoria Street Access Returns Monday to UIC-Halsted Stop

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that pedestrian access from Peoria Street to the UIC-Halsted station on the Chicago Transit Authority’s Blue Line will be restored, weather permitting, Monday.

Access will be restricted to a designated route through the work zone from Harrison and Van Buren streets while construction continues on the Peoria Street bridge over the Eisenhower Expressway (Interstate 290), part of the overall reconstruction of the Jane Byrne Interchange. Riders with disabilities still can access the platform via the elevator on Halsted Street.

The bridge project, scheduled to be complete later this fall, includes rebuilding the UIC-Halsted station.
