## **Lane Reductions on U.S. 12/Illinois 59 in Volo**

**CHICAGO** – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that U.S. 12/Illinois 59 between Sullivan Lake Road and Molidor Road, in Volo, will be reduced to one lane when workers are present for intersection improvements and the installation of new traffic signals, beginning, weather permitting, Monday, Aug. 24.

In order to complete the work, traffic lanes will be reduced during the daytime hours on U.S. 12/Illinois 59 at the intersections with Sullivan Lake Road and Molidor Road. Traffic lanes will also be reduced to one lane in each direction, with flaggers, on Sullivan Lake Road and Molidor Road while workers are present.

The project will be complete by June 2016.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
