## **Harlem Avenue Closure at BNSF Crossing in Riverside**

**CHICAGO** – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that Harlem Avenue (Illinois 43) will be fully closed to traffic at the Burlington Northern Santa Fe Railroad tracks north of Ogden Avenue for repairs to the railroad crossing, beginning, weather permitting, the morning of Thursday, Aug. 27.

A detour will be posted. Southbound traffic will use Cermak Road, First Avenue (Illinois 171) and Ogden Avenue to reconnect with Harlem Avenue. Northbound traffic will follow the reverse route.

The project will be complete by the afternoon of Sept. 4.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
