

This is to inform you that the Illinois Department of Transportation in conjunction with the Belt Railway Company of Chicago are planning to reconstruct the deteriorated at-grade crossing on Archer Avenue east of IL 50 (Cicero Avenue) in the City of Chicago, Cook County. Archer Avenue will be fully closed to through just east of Cicero Avenue at the Belt Railway Company of Chicago tracks. The closure will begin on Monday, May 5, 2014 at 9:00 AM and conclude on or before Sunday, May 11, 2014 at 9:00 AM.

The posted detour route for eastbound traffic on Archer Avenue is to proceed southbound on IL 50 (Cicero Avenue), to eastbound 55<sup>th</sup> Street, to northbound Pulaski Road back to Archer Avenue. The posted detour route for westbound traffic on Archer Avenue is to proceed southbound on Pulaski Road, to westbound on 55<sup>th</sup> Street, to northbound IL 50 (Cicero Avenue) back to Archer Avenue.
