IDOT: Lane Closures on IL 43/Harlem Avenue from 47th Street to I-55 to Begin April 21


CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that weather permitting, a bridge repair project on IL 43/Harlem Avenue from 47th Street to I-55 in the village of Lyons, will begin Monday, April 21, 2014.

This project will have three stages with one lane closed in each stage. During stage one, the right lane and sidewalk southbound will be closed. During stage two, the center lane southbound will be closed. During stage three, the left lane and sidewalk southbound will be closed. These improvements will repair the bridge joints and patch the deck. The anticipated completion date for this project is June 19, 2014.

Drivers should expect delays and urged to pay close attention to the signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, be on the alert for workers and equipment and be prepared to stop.
