IDOT: Night time Lane/Ramp Closures on I-290 for Stage Change to Begin April 14

CHICAGO - Starting Monday night, April 14th, weather permitting, the Eastbound I-290 lanes will be staged from Morgan to Halsted for the bridge construction of the Halsted Street Bridge. The lanes from Morgan to Halsted will be reduced to four lanes. The lanes will be narrowed to 11 foot lanes. There will be one lane to the Congress Parkway, one lane to the Westbound Kennedy ramp and two lanes to the Eastbound Dan Ryan ramp.

The closures will start at 7 p.m. until 5 a.m., from Damen Avenue to Halsted Street. The Congress Parkway will be closed from 12 a.m. to 5 a.m., the posted detour will be to the Eastbound Dan Ryan ramp, exit to the Taylor Street ramp, to Roosevelt Road, turn left onto Roosevelt Road and re-enter the Westbound I90/94 to the Congress Parkway exit ramp. The Westbound Kennedy ramp will be closed at 1 a.m. to 5 a.m., the posted detour will be to the Eastbound Dan Ryan ramp, exit to the Taylor Street ramp, turn left onto Taylor Street and re-enter the Westbound onto I90/94.

Motorists can expect delays during times when the lane closures are in effect and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signing in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
