## **Weekend I-290 Lane Closures for Maintenance Work**

**CHICAGO** – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) today announced weekend closures on the Interstate 290 (Eisenhower Expressway) westbound lanes between 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue and U.S. 12/20/45 (Mannheim Road). The closures are needed for maintenance work, which will take place, weather permitting, on Saturday, Oct. 25, and Sunday, Oct. 26.

In order to complete the work, the left lane of westbound I-290 will be closed from 11 p.m., on Saturday Oct. 25, until 8 a.m. on Sunday, Oct. 26. The two westbound right lanes will remain open.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
