## **Kennedy Bridge Repair at Irving Park Road**

**CHICAGO** - The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that bridge repairs will take place on southbound I-90/94 (Kennedy Expressway) and southbound I-94 (Edens Expressway), between Lawrence Avenue and Irving Park Road, weather permitting, overnight on Saturday, Oct. 25, and into Sunday morning, Oct. 26.

In order to complete the work, the inbound two right lanes of I-90/94 will be closed between Lawrence Avenue and the Edens junction from 11:59 p.m. Saturday until 8 a.m. Sunday.

Additionally, the right two lanes of I-94 will be closed between Lawrence Avenue and the Kennedy between 11:59 p.m. on Saturday, and 8 a.m. on Sunday. The right three lanes will be closed between the Kennedy junction and Irving Park Road as well. The Kennedy reversible lanes will be directed inbound to help alleviate traffic congestion in the work zone.

The project will include bridge joint repairs, pavement patching, as well as superstructure and substructure repairs.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
