## **Sunday Morning Lane Closures along the Eisenhower for Bridge Inspections**

**CHICAGO** – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that lane closures will occur along Interstate 290 (Eisenhower Expressway) for a routine bridge inspection, weather permitting, the morning of Sunday, April 26.

In order to complete the work, lane closures will occur along I-290 from Harlem Avenue (Illinois Route 43) to Austin Avenue. Two lanes in both directions of I-290 to be closed between the hours of 5:30 a.m. and 8 a.m., and one lane in both directions closed between the hours of 8 a.m. and 11 a.m. The closures will occur in a moving operation alternating between the inbound and outbound expressway. One lane will remain open at all times in both directions of I-290.

All lanes will be reopened by 11 a.m. on Sunday.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
