## **Lanes reduced, closed along East End Avenue for resurfacing and modernization Project**

**CHICAGO** – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that a resurfacing and traffic signal modernization project will begin along East End Avenue in South Chicago Heights and Chicago Heights, weather permitting, Monday, April 27. Planned work on project includes pavement patching, milling of existing surface, placement of new hot mix asphalt surface course and traffic signal modernization.

In order to complete the work, lane reductions and closures will occur on East End Avenue, but will change day to day between 25th Street and 31st Street. The resurfacing project will occur on East End Avenue. The traffic signal modernization project will occur at 26th Street and Saulk Trail Road.

The project is slated to be complete by mid-September.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
