175th Street Closure Begins Aug. 22

CHICAGO - The Illinois Department of Transportation announced that as part of the ongoing widening and reconstruction of U.S. 45 (LaGrange Road) in Orland Park, Palos Park, Orland Hills and Tinley Park, 175th Street between U.S. 45 and 94th Avenue, in Tinley Park, will close Friday, Aug. 22.

The closure is necessary for the reconstruction of the 175th Street intersection at U.S. 45. 175th Street will reopen to traffic in mid-September. Drivers should follow the posted detour on 94th Avenue, 179th Street, and U.S. 45. Motorists will still be able to access all businesses along 175th Street.

Motorists can expect delays during times when the lane closures are in effect and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signing in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
