Lane Closures on Roosevelt Road in Cicero Begin Monday

CHICAGO - The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that a resurfacing project on Roosevelt Road between Laramie Avenue and Pulaski Road in Cicero will begin, weather permitting, on Monday, Sept. 15.

In order to complete the work, motorists can expect daily lane closures with flaggers at various locations once construction begins. The anticipated completion date for this project is Nov. 14.

Motorists can expect delays and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
