IDOT: Road Closure on IL 173 in Village of Richmond to Begin June 2

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that weather permitting and in conjunction with the Wisconsin & Southern Railroad Company, work to the deteriorated at-grade crossing on IL 173 west of Keystone Road in the Village of Richmond, will begin Monday, June 2, 2014.


Reconstruction of the at-grade crossing will require IL 173 to be fully closed just west of Keystone Road at the Wisconsin & Southern tracks. The closure will begin on Monday, June 2, 2014 at 9 a.m. and conclude on or before Sunday, June 8 at 9 a.m.

The posted detour route for eastbound traffic on IL 173 is to proceed southbound on Greenwood Road, to eastbound Vanderkarr Road/Tryon Grove Road, to northbound Keystone Road back to IL 173. The posted detour route for westbound traffic on IL 173 is to proceed southbound on Keystone Road, to westbound on Vanderkarr Road/Tryon Grove Road, to northbound Greenwood Road back to IL 173.

Motorists can expect delays during this closure and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to signing in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
