IDOT: Road Closure on IL 50 (Cicero Avenue) at Archer Avenue in Chicago to Begin May 5

CHICAGO – The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) in conjunction with the Belt Railway Company of Chicago announced that weather permitting, reconstruction to the deteriorating at-grade crossing on Archer Avenue east of IL 50 (Cicero Avenue) in the City of Chicago, will begin Monday, May 5, 2014.

Archer Avenue will be fully closed at the Belt Railway Company tracks beginning at 9 a.m. Monday, May 5, 2014 and reopen on or before 9 a.m. on Sunday, May 11, 2014.

The following detour route will be posted:


Eastbound traffic on Archer Avenue is to proceed southbound on IL 50 (Cicero Avenue), to eastbound 55th Street, to northbound Pulaski Road back to Archer Avenue.

Westbound traffic on Archer Avenue is to proceed southbound on Pulaski Road, to westbound on 55th Street, to northbound IL 50 (Cicero Avenue) back to Archer Avenue.

Motorists can expect delays during times when the lane closures are in effect and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to signing in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
