IDOT: Bridge Repairs on IL Route 53 SB over US 14 in Palatine Friday Night & Saturday Morning

Chicago- The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that weather permitting, a bridge inspection and repairs on the structure carrying Illinois Route 53 southbound over US 14 in the Village of Palatine, will occur overnight Friday, May 9, 2014.

In order to complete the work, it will be necessary to close the right lane of IL 53 SB and the entrance ramp from US 14 to IL 53 SB from 9 p.m. Friday night until 9 a.m. Saturday morning. A minimum of two lanes will be open at all times.

Due to the short duration of the closure, a detour for the closed ramp will not be posted. A suggested detour for the closed ramp is to take US 14 westbound to Palatine Road, then go eastbound to IL 53, where the ramp to southbound will be open.

Motorists can expect delays during times when the lane closures are in effect and should allow extra time for trips through this area. Drivers are urged to pay close attention to flaggers and signing in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, and be on the alert for workers and equipment.
