IDOT: Major Traffic Stage Change on IL 59 in Naperville/Aurora to Begin Week of April 21

Chicago- The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) announced that as part of the on-going roadway reconstruction project on IL 59 in Naperville and Aurora, a major traffic stage change will begin the week of Monday, April 21, 2014.


Traffic on IL 59 at the BNSF railroad viaduct, which is 1,000 feet south of North Aurora Road, will be reduced from two lanes to one lane in each direction.

The project consists of 1.57 miles of roadway reconstruction, resurfacing, retaining walls, noise abatement walls, lighting, traffic signals and other work on IL 59 from New York Street to N. Aurora Road in Naperville and Aurora. The anticipated completion date for this project is September 30, 2015.

Drivers are urged to pay close attention to the signs in the work zones, obey the posted speed limits, be on the alert for workers and equipment, expect delays and be prepared to stop.
