Dixon, IL – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces today that weather permitting, construction work on IL 75 in Freeport will begin on Monday, September 22, 2014. Fischer Excavating is starting the \$1.9 million project to reconstruct the section of IL 75 (Adams Avenue and Clark Street) from Stephenson Street to Chicago Avenue.

The project includes replacing the road pavement and sidewalks; adding a multi-use path; and replacing all the sanitary and water lines in the area. Motorists should expect lane closures as preliminary work is started next week.

On Monday, September 29, the section of IL 75 will be closed to begin removal and replacement of the sanitary line under the street. Traffic will be detoured around the work area using Stephenson Street and Main Street to Galena Avenue. The roadway is scheduled to be reopened by November 24, 2014.

Drivers are asked to be alert for the changed traffic patterns and construction vehicles in the area. Access will be maintained to all businesses during the project.
