Dixon, IL – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces today that weather permitting, construction work on I-88 east of I-80 will begin on Monday, September 29, 2014. Improvements are starting for the 14 mile section of I-88 from I-80 to the Whiteside-Rock Island County Line. Advanced Asphalt Company is the contractor for the \$15.6 million project.

Traffic will be restricted to one lane in each direction as deteriorated sections of the concrete pavement are removed and replaced. The pavement repairs are scheduled to be completed this fall. Resurfacing the roadway will be completed during the 2015 construction season.

Motorists should be alert for the lane closures, workers next to the travel lane, and slow moving construction vehicles.

Please slow down and use extreme caution while driving through all work zones.
