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Dixon, IL – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces the following update to the project to reconstruct the section of River Drive from 19<sup>th</sup> Street to 23<sup>rd</sup> Street in Moline. Due to the cold weather, concrete paving operations will be suspended for the winter.

If weather conditions permit on Monday, December 8, 2014, pavement markings will be placed between 23<sup>rd</sup> Street and the exit ramp from I-74. This will allow traffic traveling southbound on I-74 from Iowa to exit to River Drive and use the new pavement to access 23<sup>rd</sup> Street and downtown Moline.

The entrance ramp to I-74 and the section of River Drive from the interstate ramps to 19<sup>th</sup> Street will remain closed until the pavement can be completed next spring.

McCarthy Improvement Company is the contractor for the \$6.9 million project that began on September 2, 2014. The reconstruction of River Drive is the first Illinois contract to make improvements in preparation of the planned new I-74 bridge over the Mississippi River.
