Ottawa – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that the IL 23-Union Pacific Railroad grade crossing south of DeKalb will be closed on Monday, June 1, 2015. IL 23 will be closed for approximately seven days to allow the Union Pacific Railroad to rebuild their crossing. IL 23 traffic will proceed as follows:

IL 23 southbound traffic will proceed east on Fairview Drive to Peace Road; thence south on Peace Road to Gurler Road; thence west on Gurler Road back to IL 23.

IL 23 northbound traffic will proceed east on Gurler Road to Peace Road; thence north on Peace Road to Fairview Drive; thence west on Fairview Drive back to IL 23.
