The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that the US 34-BNSF Railway Company grade crossing in Mendota will be closed on Sunday, October 25, 2015. US 34 will be closed for approximately seven days to allow the BNSF Railway Company to relay heavier rail through the crossing, which is part of a larger project of relaying heavier rail through Mendota. US 34 traffic will proceed as follows:

US 34 eastbound traffic will proceed north on Main Street to Eighth Street; thence east on Eighth Street back to US 34.

US 34 westbound traffic will proceed west on Eighth Street to Main Street; thence south on Main Street back to US 34.

In addition to the US 34 grade crossing closure, the BNSF Railway will also have the Fifth Street crossing closed.
