Ottawa, IL – The Illinois Department of Transportation announced today that the US 34-Union Pacific Railroad grade crossing near Earlville will be closed on Monday, July 6, 2015. US 34 will be closed for approximately seven days to allow the Union Pacific Railroad to rebuild their crossing. US 34 will proceed as follows:

US 34 westbound traffic will proceed north on CH 41/South Ottawa Street to Union Street/N 45th Road; thence west on Union Street/N 45th Road to E 12th Road; thence south on E 12th Road back to US 34.

US 34 eastbound traffic will proceed north on E 12th Road to N 45th Road/Union Street; thence east on N 45th Road/Union Street to CH 41/South Ottawa Street; thence south on CH 41/South Ottawa Street back to US 34.
