U.S. 45/52 Road Work Starts

(Milling and Resurfacing in Bourbonnais)

Ottawa, IL – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that (weather permitting) work will begin on April 6, 2015 on U.S. 45/52 in Bourbonnais. The 2.0 mile project consists of milling and HMA resurfacing beginning just north of Armour Road and ending just south of Indian Oaks Road. Additional work will include traffic signal loop detector replacement at various intersections as well as reconstruction of existing sidewalk ramps along U.S. 45/52.

A \$1,287,120.10 contract has been awarded to Gallagher Asphalt Corp. of Thornton, IL for the work. The contract is anticipated to be complete by August.

Motorists are encouraged to use extreme caution when traveling through the work zone and to be alert for changing traffic patterns, flaggers and all other workers.

Please slow down and use extreme caution while driving through all work zones.
