**PEORIA** – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces work will resume Tuesday, April 1<sup>st</sup> on I-74 between I-474 and I-155 in Morton. Lane closures on eastbound and westbound I-74 can be expected Tuesday through Friday of next week between 5:30 p.m. and 6:30 a.m.

These lane closures are necessary for construction of temporary pavement and setting of temporary barrier wall.

The speed limit through the entire work zone will be reduced to 45 mph beginning Monday, March 31<sup>st</sup> and will continue through the construction season. The work zone speed limit is in effect at all hours, whether or not workers are present.

The overall project is the complete reconstruction of I-74 from Pleasant Hill Road to Morton Avenue in Tazewell County. The project is expected to be completed in 2015.
