PEORIA – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that work will begin this week at the intersection of IL 8 (Farmington Road) and Sterling Avenue in West Peoria.

Work this week includes changing the traffic pattern on Farmington Road, beginning installation of temporary traffic signals, and installation of storm sewer. Lane closures are expected to begin Wednesday, April 23rd.

The overall project consists of geometric improvements for the right turn lane carrying Sterling Avenue traffic onto Farmington Road, relocation of traffic signals, pavement widening, and storm sewer installation.

The project is expected to be completed by September.
