Interstate 39 Work Scheduled Near Normal

Normal, Illinois – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that 5 miles of Interstate 39 is slated to be rubblized and resurfaced with hot mix asphalt starting August 1, 2014, weather permitting. The project runs from just north of Interstate 55 north of Normal (mile marker 1) to just south of Hudson (mile marker 5). During construction, one lane of traffic will be maintained.

The overall project is anticipated to be complete by December 5 of this year, weather permitting. The contractor for the \$12,700,000 project is Rowe Construction Company.

Special care will be needed as construction trucks will enter and leave the open lane of traffic. These trucks will be moving at a slow rate of speed and motorists will need to be alert.
