U.S. 24 and U.S. 51 patching

Highways to be patched

Clinton – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that weather permitting; work is scheduled to begin September 15, 2014 for pavement patching on U.S. 24 from west of Chenoa to the Livingston County line and on U.S. 51 from north of Wapella to Clinton.

This project includes patching of the existing pavement in deteriorated areas. Traffic on U.S. 24 will be reduced to one lane. Traffic on U.S. 51 will be reduced to one lane in each direction. While work is on going, please observe all traffic control signs.

The anticipated completion date is October 2014, weather permitting. The contractor for the \$280,000 project is Kinney Contractors, Inc.
