I-74 Road and Bridge Repairs in Piatt County to begin April 20, 2015

Paris, IL – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that work will begin on Interstate 74 from the DeWitt County Line to 1.2 miles west of the Champaign County Line in Piatt County on April 20, 2015. The work will include 6.67 miles of resurfacing, thin concrete overlay, bridge repair and safety improvements on I-74 and at County Highway 2 at the Mansfield interchange. During construction, one lane of traffic will be maintained on all routes involved. Once the bridge work starts, there will be width restrictions during construction. During stage I the road will be posted at 15'-9". During stage II the road will be posted at 12'-9". There are 2 locations within this section that will require the width restrictions at different times so please follow the advisory signs.

The overall project has an anticipated completion date of November 30, 2015, weather permitting. The contractor for the \$ 9,848,892 project is Open Road Paving.

Motorists are advised to slow down, obey posted limits and drive carefully through this and all work zones.
