Illinois Route 9 Rehabilitation in Bloomington

Bloomington, Illinois – The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that weather permitting, work is scheduled to resume on Illinois Route 9 from Royal Pointe Drive to Towanda Barnes Road in Bloomington. This project consists of patching, milling and resurfacing of the mainline pavement with hot mix asphalt starting March 23, 2015. During construction, one lane of traffic will be maintained.

The overall project is anticipated to be complete by May 30, 2015, weather permitting. The contractor for the \$2,000,000 project is Rowe Construction Company.

Special care will be needed as construction trucks will enter and leave the open lane of traffic. These trucks will be moving at a slow rate of speed and motorists will need to be alert.
