Road Construction in Decatur

Construction Operations to begin on Lake Shore Drive (ILL 105) at U.S. Route 51

The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that work will continue on Lake Shore Drive (ILL 105) from U.S Route 36 to U.S. Route 51. Weather permitting, asphalt paving of the interchange ramps with U.S. 51 will take place over the next two weeks.

Beginning Monday, October 27, 2014 work will begin at 7:00 p.m. on the ramps. Only one ramp will be closed at a time to allow for paving. The ramps will be open by 6:00 a.m. the following morning. During that time a marked detour will be in place. Please use extra caution and follow all signs concerning the detour during this time period.

The Department of Transportation thanks you for your patience and asks that you use caution in the work zone and consider using alternate routes.
