Road Construction in Decatur

Construction Operations to resume on Lake Shore Drive (ILL 105) at U.S. Route 51

The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that work will continue on Lake Shore Drive (ILL 105) from U.S. Route 36 to U.S. Route 51. Weather permitting, work at the intersection of Jasper and Lake Shore Drive will take place over the next two weeks.

Beginning Monday, March 16, 2015, work will begin at the intersection of Jasper Street and Lake Shore Drive to remove and replace the traffic signals. Stop signs, flaggers and changeable message boards will be used during daylight hours to control traffic.

The Department of Transportation thanks you for your patience and asks that you use caution in the work zone and consider using alternate routes.
