I-64 in St. Clair County

Location – I-64 from 18th Street to east of IL 111

The Illinois Department of Transportation today announced that both westbound and eastbound I-64 will have lane closures from 18th Street to east of IL 111 beginning Monday, March 10, 2014, weather permitting as indicated below.

I-64 Westbound

I-64 Eastbound

Times		No. Lanes Closed
M - F	7 am - 10 pm	1

Sat & Sun	10 pm Fri to 7 am Mon	2 max

Signing and traffic control devices will be provided to aid motorists through the work zones. Please watch for stopped traffic, be patient, and allow extra time when traveling through the work zone. Please consider alternate routes.

These lane restrictions are necessary to perform pavement patching and widening, which is the first part of a larger overall contract that will also include bridge repair and pavement resurfacing. Additional information will be forthcoming as the project progresses.

The overall project will be completed by the winter of 2014. The contractors on this project are The Kilian Corporation of Mascoutah, IL and Keeley and Sons, Inc. of East St. Louis, IL.
