## **PRESS RELEASE**

Madison County

Location – Granite City

The Illinois Department of Transportation today announced that effective immediately a nighttime lane closure will be encountered on I-270 eastbound, from the Mississippi River Bridge to the IL 3 interchange beginning on Tuesday, May 26, 2015, weather permitting. The lane closure will begin at 9:00 p.m. and will be reopened by 5:00 a.m. the following morning. This lane closure is necessary to install new guardrail along I-270. The eastbound work will be completed by June 5, 2015.

The ongoing westbound lane closures will conclude on Wednesday, May 27, 2015.

Traffic will be guided through the work zone utilizing flaggers, traffic control devices, and traffic control signing. Please use extreme caution while traveling through the work zone.
