I-255 in Madison County

Location – I-255 between Horseshoe Lake Road and I-270

The Illinois Department of Transportation today announced that lane reductions in both the northbound and southbound lanes of I-255 between Horseshoe Lake Road and I-270 will begin on Monday, February 9, 2015, weather permitting. One of the three lanes will be closed daily between 7:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. to complete installation of guardrail end sections. This work is expected to be completed by the end of February 2015.

Significant delays are expected. Motorists are encouraged to develop and utilize alternate routes during this period. The Department asks that motorists be patient, reduce speed, watch for stopped traffic ahead, and use additional caution when traveling near and throughout this work zone.

The contractor on this project is the Kilian Corporation and Keeley & Sons Inc., a joint venture. John Scheibal is the Supervising Field Engineer for the Illinois Department of Transportation in the area. If you have any questions concerning this project, you may contact him at 618/346-3353.
