Livingston Drive in Madison County

Location – Livingston Drive from IL 4 to the Frontage Road

The Illinois Department of Transportation announced that traffic will be reduced to one lane on Livingston Drive beginning Wednesday, May 21, 2014, weather permitting. Flagger and traffic control devices will be utilized to maintain two-way traffic to place an oil and chip surface treatment on the pavement. This work is expected to be completed by June 6, 2014.

The Department asks that motorists be patient, reduce speed, and use extreme caution when traveling near and throughout this work zone. Please allow for extra time when traveling in this location and watch for stopped traffic ahead. Additional signing and traffic control devices will be provided to assist motorists through the work zones.
