I-255 & Southbound Collector/Distributor
Centerville, IL – St. Clair County

The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that on April 23, 2015 road construction will begin on I-255 near Centerville, IL weather permitting. The construction will be on the southbound Collector/Distributor ramp at I-64 and on I-255 northbound and southbound between milepost 16 to milepost 20. This work is required to patch areas where the pavement is failing and will require that the interstate be reduced from three lanes in each direction down to two or to one lane at times through May 13, 2015. The one lane reduction will only be allowed during off peak hours, which are from 6:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.

The Department asks that motorists look for ROAD CONSTRUCTION AHEAD signs, reduce speed, watch for slow moving or stopped traffic, and use additional caution when traveling near and throughout this work zone.
