I-64 – Washington County near Nashville, IL


The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that on April 23, 2015 road construction will begin on I-64 from mile post 48 to mile post 50 in the eastbound lanes near Nashville, IL weather permitting. This work is required to patch areas where the pavement is failing and will require that the interstate be reduced from two lanes in each direction to one lane through April 30, 2015.

The Department asks that motorists be patient, reduce speed, watch for stopped traffic ahead, and use additional caution when traveling near and throughout this work zone.
