## **PRESS RELEASE**

**IL 4 at I-64 RAMPS**

**Lebanon, IL – St. Clair County**

The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that on April 23, 2015 road construction will begin on IL 4 near Lebanon, IL, weather permitting. The area affected will be on the ramps to I-64 eastbound and westbound and from westbound I-64 to the IL-4 ramp to patch areas where the pavement has failed. The ramps will remain open but will be narrowed to maintain traffic. This work is to be completed by May 4, 2015.

The Department asks that motorists look for ROAD CONSTRUCTION AHEAD signs, reduce speed, watch for slow moving or stopped traffic, and use additional caution when traveling near and throughout this work zone. Flaggers will be utilized to direct traffic through work zone.
