**PRESS RELEASE**

I-57 – Marion County near Centralia, IL

The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that on June 1, 2015 road construction will begin on I-57, three miles north of Dix, IL, from mile marker 106 to mile marker 107 in the northbound right lane, and six miles south of Salem, IL, from mile marker 107.5 to mile marker 109.5 in the southbound right lane, weather permitting. This work is required to patch areas where the pavement is failing and will require that the interstate be reduced from two lanes in each direction to one lane through June 15, 2015.

The Department asks that motorists be patient, reduce speed, watch for stopped traffic ahead and use additional caution when traveling near and throughout this work zone.
