Interstate 64 – Clinton County

The Illinois Department of Transportation announces that on June 1, 2015 road construction will begin on I-64 from eastbound mile marker 31 to mile marker 35.5 and at the westbound mile marker 32 near Damiansville, IL, weather permitting. This work is required to patch areas where the pavement is failing and will require that the interstate be reduced from two lanes to one lane in each direction through June 15, 2015.

The Department asks that motorists be patient, reduce speed, watch for stopped traffic ahead and use additional caution when traveling near and throughout this work zone.
