Greenville, IL

Location – IL 127 from 0.1 miles north of the west intersection of IL 127/IL 140 southeasterly through the city of Greenville to just north of Sale Barn Avenue.

The Illinois Department of Transportation today announced that effective immediately there will be intermittent lane closures on IL 127/IL 140 through September 2015, weather permitting. This closure is necessary to repair the existing pavement, construct the ADA ramps and remove and replace existing guardrails. Please use caution when travelling through this area. Signing and traffic control devices will be utilized to aid motorists through the work zones. The contractor will be allowed to close one lane of the roadway in the north or south direction between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Two-way traffic will be maintained utilizing flaggers to direct traffic through the work zone.
